

ORDINANCE NO. 59.

TOWN OF EGAN, SOUTH DAKOTA

AN ORDINANCE FOR THE REGULATION OF SPEED OF MOTOR VEHICLES DRIVEN UPON OR OVER THE HIGHWAY, STREETS, ALLIES OR PUBLIC GROUNDS WITHIN THE TOWN OF EGAN, SOUTH DAKOTA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF EGAN, SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1.

It shall be unlawful for any person to drive a motor vehicle upon or over any of the highways, streets, allies or public grounds within the Town of Egan, South Dakota, at a speed in excess of the following:

(a) 35 miles per hour on the highway designated as State Highway 34 within the municipality of Egan.

(b) 25 miles per hour upon any other street, alley or public ground within the Town of Egan, South Dakota.

Section 2.

Any person violating the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by fine not exceeding \$100.00.

Section 3.

All previous Ordinances, or parts of Ordinances, which are in conflict with the foregoing are hereby repealed and this Ordinance shall become effective and in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
