

ORDINANCE NO. 109

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING FIREWORKS WITHIN THE TOWN OF EGAN.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Town of Egan, South Dakota, as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person or organization within the Town of Egan to manufacture, store, display, sell or discharge any fireworks. It shall also be unlawful for any person or organization having stored any fireworks in the Town of Egan prior to the effective date of this Ordinance to move such fireworks to any other building or place within the Town of Egan or to bring in and store additional and/or new fireworks within the Town of Egan.

Section 2. The term "fireworks" as used in this article refers to firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, roman candles, toy pistols, toy cannons, detonating canes, smoke bombs, blank cartridges and other devices designed and intended for pyrotechnic display.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall not apply to any public fireworks or pyrotechnic displays approved in writing by the Town Board.

Section 4. Anyone guilty of violating this Ordinance shall be subject to a fine of not more than One Hundred and no/100 (\$100.00) Dollars and/or confinement for not more than ten (10) days.
