

ORDINANCE #95

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING EXHIBITION DRIVING

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN OF EGAN, SOUTH DAKOTA:

1. Any person who drives a vehicle within the city of Egan, in such a manner that creates or causes unnecessary engine noise, or tire squeal, skid or slide upon acceleration or stopping; or that stimulates a temporary race, or that causes the vehicle to unnecessarily turn abruptly or sway shall be guilty of Exhibition Driving.

2. Any person violating the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding \$100.00.

3. That whereas this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public peace, safety and support of the Municipal Government of Egan and shall take effect upon its passage and publication as required by law.
