

ORDINANCE #166

**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING
REGULATIONS FOR USE OF THE EGAN CITY BRUSH PILE.**

Section 1. – Establishment of Brush Pile

1.1 Egan City Board of Trustees has established the site of a brush pile for use of city maintenance personnel and city residents for the disposal of branches and other debris collected from the trimming of and maintenance of trees. No other material or debris of any kind is to be dropped off at this site.

Section 2. – Definitions

2.1 Debris from the trimming and maintenance of trees is defined as raked leaves, branches, twigs, trunks and other portions of trees that may be cut or trimmed. Also included are grass clippings from lawn mowing.

2.2 City maintenance personnel are defined as Egan City employees who are hired to perform maintenance duties.

2.3 City residents are defined as those persons living within the city limits of the City of Egan.

Section 3. - Maintenance of Brush Pile


3.1 On a regular basis, city maintenance personnel with the assistance of the Egan Volunteer Fire Department will burn the brush pile and clean up the area.


Section 4. – Violations

4.1 Persons who dump debris of any kind other than tree and brush debris will be reported to the appropriate law enforcement authorities. Fines for illegal dumping will be up to \$200.00 for each act.
